Go-Karting at Arnold's



The car clubs at the beach have the right idea all boardwalk shows attract a crowd. I felt we needed a show like that. The problem was where? It was difficult to find the ideal location that would allow us to put on a show. In an unusual moment of clarity it came to me, Becky's Drive-In Theatre. It was perfect they can hold 750 plus cars. They were built for vehicular traffic. They have a concession building that can feed us breakfast, lunch and dinner. They have bathrooms. They have a booth that we can use to collect the registration fees. They have an FM transmitter that they use to transmit the audio signal for the movies that we can use for music and announcements if we wish. All the metal speaker poles are gone which gives the place to park and look and without dented doors. After the event we can hang around and watch two full length feature films if we wish. Becky's is located about 15 miles north of Allentown, PA, right down the road from the town of Jim Thorpe in the mountains, a very scenic drive.

We will offer a gimmick rally for and additional fee, free slow drag race, Corvette trivia contest throughout the day and the movies will be extra of course. I was very pleased to see the level of commitment to help, the enthusiasm was overwhelming. 
