# CCDV WEB-SITE

Before I go into the "*Raison d'être*" of this article I would like to make clear the purpose of the web site and its audience. As everyone is aware, the **CCDV** web-site is used in many different ways to communicate and share our activities, feelings, thoughts, car related topics, good times, pictures, etc. Our site is local based and small in nature with the primary intention to communicate within our membership. However the audience that can access our web site, both member or non-member, is very wide spread and diversified as such to include our members, spouses, sons and daughters, other car clubs, everyday people throughout the U.S.A. and I wouldn't be surprised if GM Corvette personnel read our posts.

Now with that said, on numerous occasions within the last few months, members of the club have made comments to me concerning the web-site and how it is being used. There were also web-site comments listed in the survey I distributed at the August and September General Membership meetings. Since I represent all our members, I thought I would use this forum to share their concerns and maybe put some perspective around what is being perceived, as well as what could be focused upon to change some of this perception. I can only share the thoughts of the members who have spoken out; I do not know what the others are thinking.

Although we have very strict rules concerning the truly inappropriate material that the moderators govern, I felt there was something else the members were trying to say. So after hearing some of the concerns, I randomly selected some other members in order to get a broader insight of the situation. The consensus is that we are a premier club with a lot of character, compassion and class, but at times the dialog or comments on the web-site are not written with respect or maturity. After gathering their thoughts I will try to be precise and concise on what I heard.

- At times **Displeasure** is written in the form of anger or bashing.
- At times **Disagreement** is written in the form of rage or conflict.
- At times the **Anger** or **Rage** is supported with expletives but using the special characters or an abbreviated word.
- At times innuendos are used as a means to send a message that is negative toward an individual.

Everyone understands the forum is a means to communicate, but they feel the way things are presented could be handled differently. Some have taken offense to this and have suggested the Board remove the access rights for some and or even shut down the web-site. It was also stated that this could contribute to the decline in number of members posting.

I do not feel anyone's access should be removed or the web-site shut down without first reaching out to our web-site users and making everyone aware as to what is being perceived. I know when a member writes a post it is not intended to be disrespectful or cause someone to be upset. But people do perceive things in their own ways so I'm asking everyone to take into consideration the audience that read our posts. At times you might want to re-read your post before submitting. Like I said earlier, we are a club with character, compassion and class. Let's not have our audience view us any differently.

If you wish to comment or express your thoughts on this article, please do so at the October GM meeting where I will be conducting an **Open Forum**.

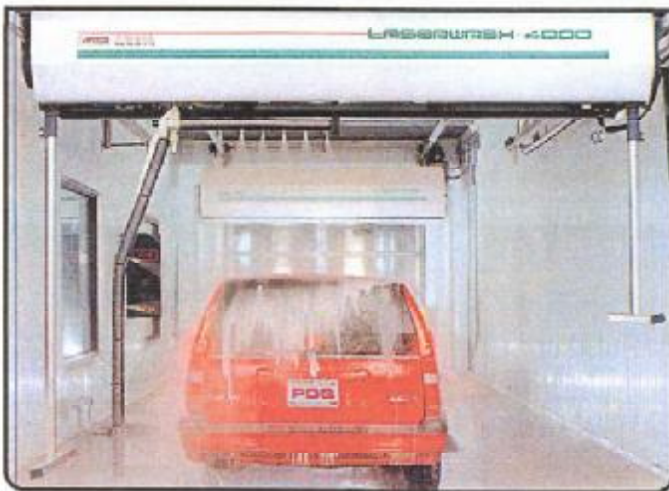
