In many instances, these soldiers come in with little or no clothes or uniforms due to their injuries. The soldiers lack just about everything that we take for granted in our everyday lives such as sunscreen, deodorant, soap, toothpaste, clean socks, underwear, etc. The list (page 5) goes on and on.

Kelsey Sandler, 12 (who will turn 13 on September 9th) the youngest daughter of CCDV member **carboman** has offered to spearhead this drive to **Support the Troops** and we would like to assist by trying to spread the word to all our Corvette friends in an effort to help Kelsey support our troops.

We would like to collect as much as we can and ship the collected items to the men and women that serve our country and protect us all at the risk of their own lives.

We are setting up a collection point and offering hot dogs, chips and sodas to anyone that would like to stop by. We will have a few Corvettes on display by our Chevrolet tent with plenty of parking and plenty of other Corvettes, I'm sure just hanging around. Come stay as long as you like. Saturday, September 8, 2007, anytime between 9:30 AM through 4:00 PM at 985 Milkweed Lane, Huntington Valley, PA 19006, (in Eastern Montgomery County, near Bucks and Philadelphia Counties).

From Philadelphia: I-95 to exit 35 (Woodhaven Rd) Follow Woodhaven Rd straight ahead to the very end. At the end you must turn left. Follow to traffic signal and turn right onto Byberry Rd. Follow Byberry Rd for 4 miles to route 232. Turn right onto 232 and then take very next right onto Warfield Rd into the neighborhood, then follow the Support the Troops signs to the Corvettes on display.

From Doylestown: Rte 611 south to County Line Road, turn left onto County Line Rd and follow for 6 miles to Rte 232. Turn right onto Rte 232, follow ¾ mile and turn left onto Warfield Rd, then follow the Support the Troops signs to the Corvettes on display

They award a lot of unusual trophies here, for example: they award trophies for the car with the worst spare tire or the most overdue inspection sticker or the car with the most bird poop hits on it. You get the idea right? CCDV has won the most attended club award \$100 for the last two years in a row.

Gone Fishin'



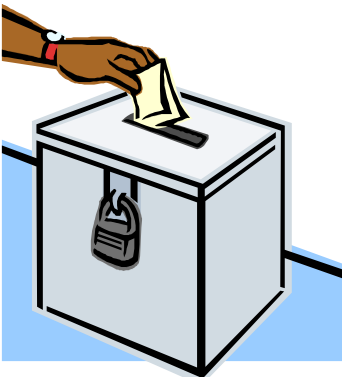
With no Corvette Challenges since July 14th, Tony has gone fishing with Rose. He has promised to return in time for the October Gas Cap.
