- ✓ A motion was passed to donate \$15,050 to the charities and to hold \$950 for future donations. Recipients of donations for this year are the Sunshine Foundation, JDF, Multiple Sclerosis, Saint Mary's Villa, MANNA on Main Street Soup Kitchen, Warrington Ambulance, Alzheimer's Research Foundation, and Neal Hirshburg (private donation).
- ✓ Elections were held for 2009 CECF elections. The winners were Bob Weiss, Joe Remich, and Steve Howard.
- ✓ A motion was passed to purchase a 2004 black Corvette Coupe for next year's raffle car at a cost of \$23,999. The car has approximately 3500 miles.
- ✓ The Board discussed the current club brick at the National Corvette Museum. These bricks are one of the first club arrangements at the museum and they are surrounded by several club members' individual bricks that were purchased specifically to be placed around the club brick arrangement.
- ✓ A motion was not passed to reduce the dues for the upcoming year (only) to \$35.
- ✓ As a result of very successful Cruise Nights this year, \$500 will be donated to Gilda's Club.


