CCDV 2007 Semi-Annual President's Award

Early in **2005** I asked the Board to allow me to present a form of recognition to any member whose contributions, enthusiasm and commitment to the club was at the highest level. Throughout the year we continually give recognition through verbal or written communication such as a simple *Thank you* or a physical means such as a trophy, but I was looking at this at a different perspective. Realizing we are a premier club and such an award is warranted, the Board approved the idea. I named it the **CCDV President's Award** and wanted it presented on a semi-annual basis because of to the number of people who participate in our club activities past or present. I felt the award should have no boundaries such as what year the recognition was deserved, how many years someone is a member or the type, level or number of activities. But this would not be your average type of award, as it would require hard work and a significant contribution to our club and its members. The award is 10 inches high, has a contemporary design and made of blue acrylic with white lettering.

The second **2007** recipient of this semi-annual award was presented to **Bob Weiss** at February's General Membership meeting. His contributions and efforts as a member for the last eighteen years have been above and beyond. Since joining the Club in 1990 Bob has played so many roles, including CCDV President in 1994, 1995 & 1996, CECF president since 1997 and he was also the Vice President as well as Chairman of the Board during his years as a member. He has been on the Board since 1991 and was the driving force behind the creation of CECF which is the foundation through which we administer our donations to charities. Highlights from the February 21, 2008 CCDV Board Meeting

- ✓ The club received a certificate for sponsoring the Corvette Challenge.
- ✓ A motion was passed to approve a budget of \$1,300 for the Corvette Roundup Car Show.
- ✓ Dolores Howell donated \$500 to the club to be used at the discretion of the club.
- ✓ A motion was passed to expend \$500 from CECF funds for the SADD conference.
- ✓ Ed Bonk will address the membership and possibly form a committee to look at boundaries and the openness of the forum.
- ✓ Six new membership application(s) were approved. The new candidate(s) are: Gregory Baugher, Janice Baugher (spousal), Brian Garforth, Diane Garforth (spousal), William Kinsley, and Manny Maldonado. Total membership stands at 605 members including the new member(s). We are at 458 renewals for 2008.
- ✓ A motion was passed to approve the purchase of a 1999 Corvette coupe for \$19,750.
- ✓ Jeff Hey and Stan O'Leary were reappointed for a two year term on the Board of CECF.
- ✓ This year's Cavalcade will be held on June 21st with a rain date of June 28th. The show
 will end at 3:30PM due to a conflict with the Lansdale Car Show. There will be no
 judging this year. There will be a craft show, slow drag competition, and tire changing
 competition again.
- ✓ A motion was passed to approve a total show budget of \$8,500 for the 2008 Cavalcade.
- ✓ Three additional \$1,000 donations were made to the scholarship growth fund in 2008 by Jeff & Kathy Hey, Mike & Marie McHenry, and Duane & Judy Wilson.
- ✓ A motion was passed to approve \$100 for flowers to be displayed at Mr. Charles Peterson's funeral services.
- ✓ A motion was passed to approve \$1,050 for sponsorship of the 2008 Corvette Challenge.
- ✓ A replacement brick arrangement at the NCM was discussed. It would be four new bricks and we would change the wording. A motion was not passed to approve \$600 to update the NCM bricks.


