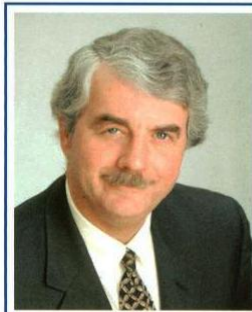

The outcome of these forums was very beneficial and instrumental in moving forward with change. Here is a re-cap of the past four years. The changes are listed in no particular order.

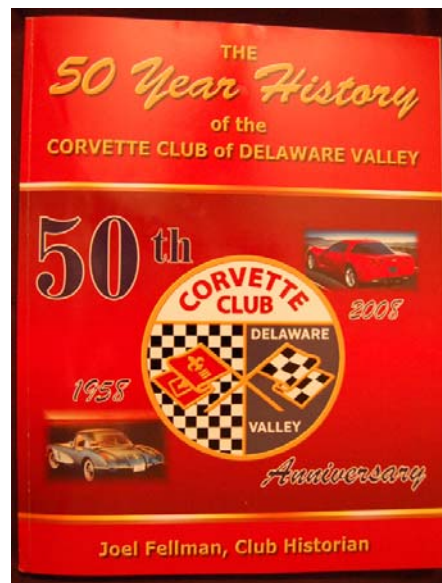
