GUIDELINES:

- 1. You may submit 1 to 3 images. No more.
- 2. Specify the following specs for publication with the photo(s):
 - Your Full Name and CCDV website online name (if any)
 - o Model Year
 - Exterior Color Name
 - Engine Type (eg. L48) and/or Size (eg. 350/174hp)
 - Any special type (eg. Collector's Edition, Silver Anniversary, etc)
 - Year Purchased
 - Where photo was taken, if you think it is worthy of mention
- 3. Specify how you want your name associated with the image(s) if used. You may specify one of the following:
 - Do not use your name
 - Specify your online name and your Real First Name
 - o Specify your online name and your Real First & Last Name
- 4. Specify how you want your location associated with the picture if it is used. You may specify one of the following:
 - Do not use your location
 - Specify your City and State

All submissions will be reviewed and judged on the following criteria:


- 1. **Quality** *THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT!!!* The image file must be of a substantial quality in regards to DPI (eg. 300) and Resolution (eg. 1760x1168). The higher these numbers are, the better it will look when printed, especially on a calendar. You'll probably need a 2.1 megapixel camera or better, set at the highest quality setting possible.
- 2. **Artfulness** The image should be tasteful and free of anything that would detract from the Vette. For example, **no people, no other cars, no business signs.** Examples of good backgrounds are: open fields, a park, a tree-lined 2-lane road, your driveway, etc.
- 3. **Framing** Framed so that the entire Vette is in the picture. It can be taken from any angle except straight on of the rear.
- 4. Scenery The prettier the background, the better. Plus, keep in mind that we'd like to have season appropriate photos. For example, a background of trees turning color in the fall; trees and flowers blooming in the spring; snow covered roadway in the winter, pumpkin patch for October, etc.

The more of these criteria that you meet, the more likely your photo will be used.

TO SUBMIT YOUR VETTE:

- Making sure to follow all the guidelines above, send your Vette & Personal Details and image file(s) as attachments or by specifying URL(s) to: CCno+spamDV@C3VRMail.com Make sure to remove no+spam from the email address!!
- 2. Entries must be received no later than 10/31/2009!

CCDV 'Help Each Other' Project

The CCDV Board has suggested that being able to offer help for club members who has experienced an unexpected breakdown with their Corvette is a good idea. A small sub-committee was established with Bruce Waldron, Patty Nolan, Mark Krapf, and Jack Householder to develop a plan for implementation.

However, before an extended effort is put forward to make this happen, it was felt important to know in advance that the membership majority would be prepared to participate.

The basic idea is the following:

- 1. A list of club members (who have agreed in advance) will be made available to other club members. At a minimum the list will include the Club Member's Name, Cell Phone Number, and Town Location (such as Bensalem, Lansdale, or Warminster). This would allow the broken down member to select a phone number closest to their current location.
- 2. A number of ideas have been suggested for distribution options including, but not limited to, from a download list available on the website to a 'real time lookup' with your iPhone.
- 3. Care is being given to insure minimum security risks to individual participants.
- 4. Maybe it would be helpful to know that this member had a C3 or a C6. These are all possibilities.
- 5. No one's name would be included without written approval in advance.

Soon, there will be a place that you can provide your feedback on the 'members' only portion' of our website (positive and / or suggestions). Based on the number of positive responses (looking for a minimum of 100), a formal proposal will be put forward to the board for approval in the Oct/Nov timeframe so that it can be rolled out in 2010.

What the heck is this about?

In Newport R.I. there are a group of <u>mansions</u> that where built during America's gilded age by Industrial Giants such as Carnegie, Vanderbilt etc...The Newport Mansions Organization <u>www.newportmansions.org</u> has returned the mansions to their original condition and has opened them for public viewing.

Why am I telling you this?

We are putting together a road trip to tour the Mansion at Newport, RI its about 260 miles a 5 to 6 hour drive from Willow Grove, PA (depending on the strength of your bladder). We will drive up on Friday Oct.2nd check into the Hotel (TBD) go to dinner (TDB). Saturday and Sunday will be spent touring the mansions. Sometime during the weekend we will take a 10 mile scenic ocean drive cruise which was highly recommended. Monday will be the drive home

Cost?

If we get 20 or more people interested in the trip the cost for mansion tickets are \$26 per/person if less than 20 people the cost is \$31 p/p. 





