Going Racing

The wildest Winter in recent memory is behind us now. With all the snow AND rain, I would not be surprised if the track had been washed away! Fortunately E-town came away from the Winter unscathed and it was time to go racing again! The Corvette Challenge had two races scheduled in March. The first race was a non points warm-up race; along with last years Top 16 race. The second officially kicks off the points races.

March 20th sure did not come in like a lion weather wise. The barometer was hanging around 29.90" and the temp. was in the **upper** 70's. That indicated that the cars were not going the set any speed records. I seem to remember last years first race being in the upper 70's! Ellis Gray, Jerry Muniz, Tad Archambault, John Milewski, Glenn Murphy and I made the trip to the track to get the rust out of our systems.

During the timed runs Glenn got Big Red's <u>first</u> 11 sec. time slip! 11.969 to be exact. John had a really lousy first run. Took a little advice from Glenn and then steadily improved on his next 3 timed runs. Jerry was battling a battery problem while Tad had a minor mechanical malfunction that ended his day. My car's times were anything **but** consistent, which was really disappointing with 6 timed runs! Ellis had the best qualifying session. He qualified #1 for the 11.50 index race.

John, Ellis, Jerry, and I entered the Corvette Challenge race. With some good timed runs John was stoked for his first elimination run. John gets his FIRST win. That also gets him his first trophy and a sticker. Ellis and I bow out in round 1. Jerry cut a .034 light and cruises into round two.

Round 2: John had been consistently running 12.9x's so he slapped a 12.88 on his window and strapped in for round 2. He cut a .064 light while his opponent naps his way to a .208 light. So John wins round 2 right? Unfortunately he misses a shift and could not run his number and his opponent runs him down for the win. Jerry on the other hand runs his # pretty good. He posted an 11.519 on an 11.50 dial! So it's on to round three for Jerry. That's were Jerry's Challenge day ended.

Jerry, Ellis, and I qualified for the Top 16 race. I lose in round one by .001! Jerry gets as far as round 2. Ellis gets the farthest with a semi final race. He has the race won from the start and prepares to cruise to the stripe for the win. He crosses first 3 mph slower than his usual runs but breaks out by .01! Tough way to lose \$1000.00! Ellis also made it to the semi final round in the 11.50 index race. In that race he was up against last years champ, Rob Farley. As the lights go green Ellis cuts a .023 rt to Rob's .022 rt! This is a DRAG RACE! Ellis crosses the stripe at 11.571 as Rob crosses at 11.573. Talk about a photo finish! Ellis is .00036 on the losing end!!!!!

Glenn, John, and I enter the Trophy Marathon race. Glenn spins his way to 1 round win as he had a difficult time getting Big Red to hook on street tires. I finally manage to get two round wins, the last two of the day. John was the big winner in this event with three round wins. He took home a really big trophy for his efforts!

So that wraps up the Warm – up race for the Corvette Challenge.

March 27th, felt more like December 27th. At 29* when I left my house it seemed that I should be putting my car away for the Winter! By the time the six of us made it to the track the temp shot up to

32*!!! Tony and I traveled together and met Ellis, Jerry, Tad, and Mike Campbell at the track. At least the Sun was out.

The first round of time shots were pretty much a waste of time as the track was too cold. No one had any traction. That was too bad because the DA was -2000'!!!!! So with no traction it was hard to take advantage of the "mineshaft air". Because of the poor traction the officials at Raceway Park gave us an additional time shot. That was nice as some of us were able to get a personal best time. Tony Buonassisi Got a PB with a 12.147 run at 118.70 mph. Mike Campbell got **9** personal bests! He got a PB on every run, finishing up with a 12.315 @ 115.70 mph.

As the Elimination rounds started the temp reached a balmy 40*! Tony, Tad, and I had very short runs in the Challenge as we all went out in the first round. Both Jerry and Mike made it to round three before being sent home. Ellis on the other hand won round after round until there was only one driver left! That's right Ellis made the Final Round in the Challenge. He got there the 'hard way'! Along the way he had to take out Eric Fisher (last year's runner-up), Rob Farley (last year's champ), AND Ralph Savarese (finished 3rd last year)! THAT is a TOUGH set of drivers to beat! In the Final Round he was up against Lou Calicchia, last weeks Top 16 Champ! Ellis dials 11.43 while Lou dials 11.34, almost a heads up race! Ellis gets to leave first with a .048 light with Lou a slit second behind El with a .045 RT. This is a great Final with both drivers full throttle neck and neck all the way to the stripe! Neither driver backed down, Ellis crosses at 11.490 to Lou's winning 11.378. That translated into a margin of victory of .0259! Sense a pattern here?

Ellis and Gerry also compete in the 11.50 index race. Ellis once again wins round after round until he finds himself in the Final Round of that race also! On his way to the Final Ellis meets up with Jerry in the semi final round. Even though Jerry ran a 11.50 with a 6!, Ellis takes the win with a better reaction time. In the final Ellis gets to run Eric Fisher once again, and this time takes the win on a double breakout run! Pattern broken!

Tony, Mike, and I also entered the Classic vs. Modern Muscle race. Tony takes me out in round two on his way to the semi final round. Mike makes it to the semi final also. Unfortunately that's as far as the both of them got!

All in all it was a great day racing and hanging out with friends. At the end of the day Ellis Gray is in second place in the Corvette Challenge and in first place in the 11.50 index race! Jerry and Mike are tied for sixth place in the Challenge. And believe it or not we get to do this all over again next week!
