- ✓ There was very low interest for the Longwood Gardens Event. Even though activities are planned in advance, these events compete with ad hoc events and events that are not sponsored by the club.
- It is difficult to match screen names to club member names in order to allow users into the member's only section. The web site administrators are preparing to send emails out requesting a response that would identify a user as a club member.
- ✓ It was suggested to revitalize selling items on the web site. Bill Burkholder will photograph items and work with Laura Johnson for pricing, sizing, etc.
