CCDV 15 years ago in 1997 by Joel Fellman

It was a <u>very</u> busy year! Lots of great things happened that year and a few not so great things. Here goes:

- 1997 ** Total Production of the brand new C5 is 9,752 all coupes and the lowest production since 1958 when only 9,168 were produced (except for the extremely limited few 1983's). The base Sport Coupe price = \$37,495. The totally redesigned body, suspension and interior encompass a totally new engine: the 345 HP 5.7 litre aluminum block LS1 with 350 lbs/ft. of torque able to push the 6 speed from 0-60 in 4.7 seconds, a 13.3 quarter at 109 mph and a 172 top end. New Goodyear 245/45 ZR17 up front and 275/40 ZR18 rear unidirectional Eagle F1-GS extended mobility tires, capable of running flat at 50 mph for 200 miles, eliminate the need for a spare tire. The new Vette was 1.2 inches longer and the wheelbase grew 8.3 inches, yet the total weight was reduced 80 pounds. The only exterior reference to Chevrolet was a "bowtie" on the rear license plate bracket and would be hidden by the license plate.
- **1/97** 10 CCDV members, family and friends caravan from the Willow Grove K-mart to enjoy the entertainment and dinner at Dave & Buster's on Delaware Avenue in Philadelphia, arranged by the Abneys.
- **1/97** A 1990 coupe is purchased for \$16,000 to be the next raffle Vette
- **1/97** Several CCDV members get to see the all new 1997 C5 Corvette at its first local exposure at the Philadelphia Auto Show.
- **1/97** CCDV President, Joe Clemente, appoints a committee of Will Abney, Mike Cibik, Sue Fellman and Tim Simmons to review the Club's current By-Laws and recommend any needed corrections, changes, etc.
- **1/97** 23 CCDV members, family and friends leave from Ft. Lauderdale, Florida to travel together on a Club Cruise for 8 days through the Western Caribbean, by Louann Lemek.
- **1/97** Larry Shinoda, designer of the 1963 Split Window Coupe and the Mako Shark styling, suffers complete kidney failure and requires expensive dialysis 4 times a day. Without medical insurance, a trust is established in an effort to help him with his financial burden.
- **1/97** ** CECF Treasury = \$27,339, including \$16,384 in checking plus a \$5,000 CD and money market funds of \$5,955 and in 3/97, CCDV's Treasury = \$25,934, including \$12,000 in CD's, \$9,180 in savings and \$4,754 in checking.

2/97	CCDV member, Ellis Gray, donates 2 Flyers Hockey tickets to be raffled off along with our normal 50/50 at the General Membership meeting. Guest speakers are Steve Fisher and Steve Spencer, from Bryner Chevrolet.
2/97	Will Abney challenges the January Board minutes, claiming a motion from Bob Weiss was incorrect. He insists that it be taken to a vote but the minutes are approved as originally presented.
2/97	Billy Satchell presents the Board with some possibilities for a new meeting place. Included is the Vereinigung Erzebirge German Club which eventually becomes CCDV's meeting place but not until 2005.
2/97	Bob Segal, George Alderfer, Sid Worth and Ed Johnson join CCDV.
2/97	The CCDV Board approves a newly styled Club jacket to be sold to Club members - presented by Jeff Hey.
2/97 **	The Raffle Committee, headed by Jeff Hey, purchases through CECF a beautiful 1990 Red/Red automatic coupe with approximately 35,000 miles.
3/97	CCDV members enjoy a brunch at the Cock & Bull Restaurant at Peddler's Village and brewery tour at the River House Brewery in Lambertville, NJ - arranged by Billie Satchell.
3/97	CCDV members join with members of the Del-Val NCRS Chapter to caravan from the Willow Grove K-mart to the Seven Stars Inn in Phoenixville, PA for another dinner planned by Gail Abney. Over 50 attend.
4/97	An election ballot for proposed By-Law changes is printed in this month's Gas Cap.
4/97	Jim Stemphley and Jim Gordon of County Corvette Restoration are the guest speakers at the General Membership meeting.
4/97	CCDV members, family and friends attend the 7th Annual Beef & Beer at the Willow Grove Moose Lodge, arranged by Jeff Hey. Net profit = \$800.
4/97	8 CCDV couples caravan from Pep Boys on Rt. 611 to dinner at the Blue Bell Inn arranged by Gail Abney.
4/97	Ken Lynch joins CCDV
4/97	CCDV members attend a Day at the Drags at Maple Grove Raceway arranged by Tom Bash. Bob Pollock's supercharged Wolf runs a best time of 12.60.
