Friday - 9/14. We plan to leave at 9am from a to be determined location in Quakertown. We will drive to Watertown, NY, which is approximately 290 miles, and about 5 hours. We plan to stop along the way for lunch and gas.

Dinner - We plan to eat as group at Sackets Harbor Brewing Company, (taste tested approved). See website listed below for menu. A list of other restaurants in the area will be provided if you are not interested in the Brewing Company.

Sunday, 9/16 - Breakfast at the hotel.

Today we intend to take a wine tour of the family owned Tug Hill Vineyards. We will be leaving from the hotel and driving approximately 30 minutes to Lowville, NY. Price of the wine tasting and lunch package to come.

Optional: Visit Sackets Harbor, the battlegrounds and historical sites of the war of 1812 between the British and U.S.

Dinner: We may dine with the New York Corvette Club members depending upon their availability, or on your own.

Check out of hotel. Drive home or optional drive to Canada
