BATTLESHIP NEW JERSEY TOUR



Sunday May 4th at 11:00AM we have planned a group “Fire Power” 90 minute tour of BB-62, the “Big J”.

You can go on your own or meet at 10:00 AM with others at Katie O’Donnell’s (where our Cavalcade will be held this year) located at: 4501 Woodhaven Road near the Franklin Mills Mall in the far N/E Phila, PA (conveniently located just off Rt. 95 at the Woodhaven Rd. Exit)

We will leave Katie O’s around 10:15 and try to caravan south on Rt. 95 to cross over the Ben Franklin Bridge into Camden. The ship is only about 5 minutes over the bridge.

The cost for the tour which includes seeing the weapons systems, galley, the command and control centers, etc., is \$20. for adults, \$15. for seniors or veterans and \$9. for children 5 to 11. You can also sign up for the optional 4D Flight Simulator ride for an additional \$4.

Public parking is nearby. If you choose to park directly on the landing pier in front of the ship, the cost is \$10. And it’s a good place to get a photo of your Vette.

After the tour, you can choose to:

A: remain on board for the Chowline Concession Stand lunch (in the crew’s mess hall)

B: head back to Katie O’s for lunch or

C: head on home

Some Battleship facts: Built at the Phila. Naval Yard, launched on 12/7/42 (one year after the Pearl Harbor attack), is 887 ft long, 108 ft wide and includes 9 massive 16” cannons and 20 5” guns, etc. (approximately 2 & ½ times larger than DD700-Hainsworth, the Destroyer I was stationed on with its puny 3 – 5” twin mounts)

Sometimes, we like our movies a little naughty.

There has been Billy Bob Thornton's "Bad Santa" and Cameron Diaz' "Bad Teacher." Now, the innocent but competitive world of spelling bees gets the black comedy treatment with "Bad Words."

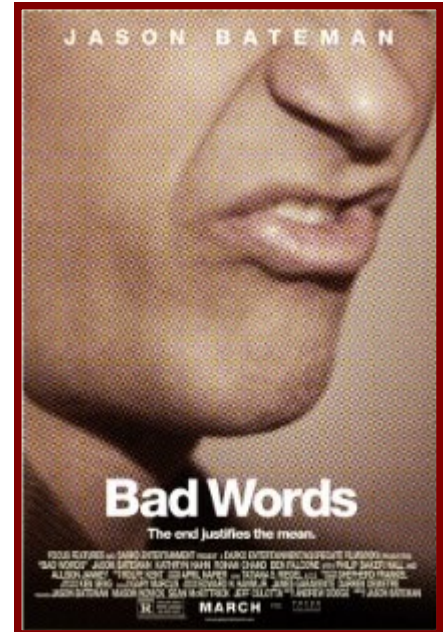
Jason Bateman, usually cast in light comedy roles, gets to play a gruff bully in a film in which he directed and stars. Bateman takes on the role of Guy Trilby, a commercial warranty proof reader who has little time for anyone. He exploits a national spelling bee loophole that allows him to compete with grade school kids and draws the outrage of parents of the younger contestants. A reporter (Kathryn Hawn) tags along to do the story and fund his quest. The two have a bumpy relationship, but often wind up between the sheets as a last resort.

The story picks up when 10-year old fellow competitor Chaitanya Chopra (Rohan Chand) befriends Trilby despite some rather funny verbal abuse. Trilby warms to the boy, because the child's relationship with his father reminds him of his own childhood. Together, the two engage in grown up adventures that include fast cars, bar hopping and the boy's brief introduction to the world of hookers.

An hour into the film, we still don't know Trilby's real motives but eventually the big reveal spells disappointment.

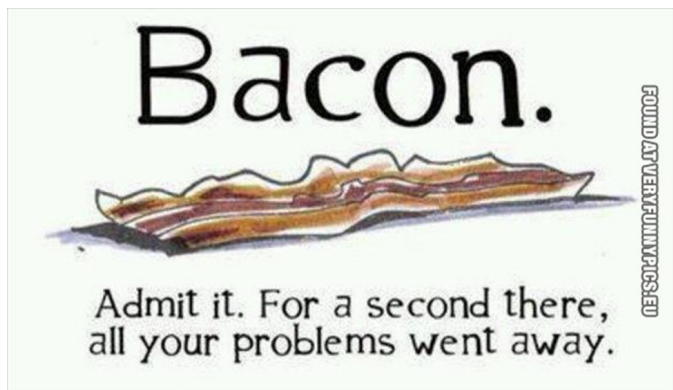

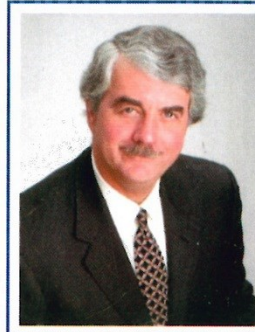

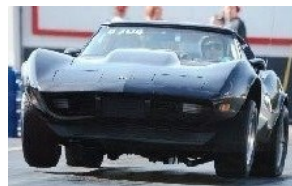
