Begin Again

Movie Review by Steve Nikazy



Two talented performers stray from their comfort zone and big screen audiences win in the new film "Begin Again."

Writer-Director John Carney ("Once") had to wonder if pop star Adam Levine had the acting chops needed to star in a movie and he was perhaps a little nervous about Keira Knightley pulling off a believable performance as a singer. No worries. "Begin Again" is a music-comedy-drama and a story of a fresh start and second chances.

Singer Dave (Levine) and songwriter Gretta (Knightley) are a romantic couple on the road to the big time but stardom leads to temptation. Gretta gets dumped and is forced to wonder about her future when she encounters down and out record executive Dan (Mark Ruffalo). During a chance encounter at a small club, Dan hears a song by Gretta that becomes a life changing experience for him. Ruffalo turns in a fine performance and his tortured past that includes a failed marriage and estranged daughter fades away during his new collaboration with a new found talent.

There are comic performances by James Corden who plays a Brit musician and friend of Gretta and CeeLo Green who plays a hip hop star owing his career to Dan.

There are funny scenes as Gretta's rag tag band performs at unauthorized locations in New York and there are touching moments about sharing music through a headphone splitter cable.

Despite the subject matter, "Begin Again" is a film that finds a fine balance of music and drama. Ultimately satisfying and a movie that rises above the roar of summer action thrillers.

The 44th Annual Cavalcade of Corvettes!

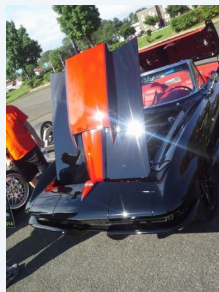

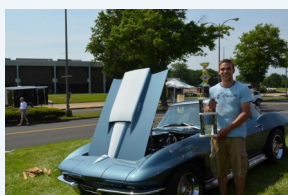

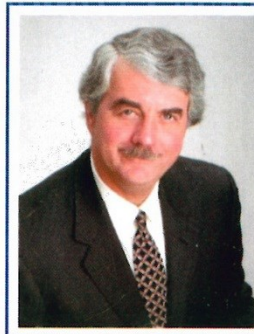
