Young parents revel in living the American Dream, complete with a newborn, a house and white picket fence, when their world collides with next door neighbor frat boys in a new comedy directed by Nicholas Stoller. Mac Radner (Seth Rogen) and wife Kelly (Rose Byrne) attempt to maintain their former childless lifestyle. One hilarious scene has them planning to attend a concert, only to tire out while packing a stroller and a truck load of baby supplies for the would be outing. Life seems good, until they encounter new neighbors, frat brothers, bent on breaking some outrageous party records set in previous years.

Mac and Kelly meet the Delta Psi Beta fraternity led by Teddy Sanders (Zac Efron), who assures them they won't be a problem. The frat breaks in the new digs with a loud beer soaked, marijuana party while Mac and Kelly wonder if they are "becoming their own parents." Repeated parties result in our couple breaking a "truce" and calling police. Battle Royale begins.

What would an R-rated frat comedy be without bawdy sight gags? We get them in droves, including a scene involving plaster casts and private parts. Mac and Kelly conspire to drive a wedge between the top frat members with an explosive love triangle and the results are hilarious.

"Neighbors" became a hard news story of sorts when Washington Post film critic Ann Hornaday linked such movies to the Elliot Rodger, UCSB killings. She contended fraternity hazing and other cinematic bullying leads to real violence. That prompted a social media response by Rogen, who tweeted that Hornaday's article was "misinformed and insulting."

"Neighbors" keg of gags is half full, compared to the classic frat comedy "Animal House" but it's not a bad way to spend about ninety minutes. Just be glad your neighbors don't have a boiler sized bong and a closet full of illegal fireworks.






