On October 13th the raffle car winner will be drawn at the general membership meeting. This is your last chance to purchase a ticket and just maybe, you may win!

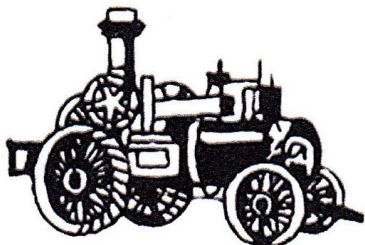

Some CCDV History From Years Gone By

Dec. 1958 – CCDV is created

Apr. 1964 – Roger Penske from Gladwyn, PA, one of CCDV's initial Club sponsors, attends the membership meeting.

Feb. 1967 – Our Club treasury is \$290.

Jan. 1971 – Our Club membership is 25 and the treasury is down to \$202.

May 1971 – Our first Cavalcade and in November we made a \$25. donation to Big Brothers Assn.

May 1975 – Our 5th Annual Cavalcade is so successful the Club donates \$3,300. to Big Brothers AND \$3,300. to American Diabetes Assn.

July 1978 – The Cavalcade Worker's Party is held aboard the "Showboat" on the Delaware River with music by the Modern Image Band.

Aug. 1981 – A Club picnic is held at Fisher's Pool in Harleysville, PA with 87 adults and 35 children attending.

July 1982 – Hy Lit is the DJ with the Purple Haze Band at our Cavalcade Worker's Party at the Holiday Inn, Ft. Washington, PA.

July 1983 – Bill Haley's Comets was the invited band.

Aug. 1983 – The Traves held "The Junk Food Jaunt" with 5 Corvettes in attendance – the next year this event becomes the ever famous "Hot Dog Run".

Oct. 1986 – CCDV has just 46 members.

Sept. 1989 – Brian & I are the only CCDV attendees at the Grand Opening of Buckingham Greene and in the rain, Don Lemek passes by in his '63 Vert with NO TOP! He claimed it "was only a problem when he had to slow down or stop!"

July 1993 – "107" CCDV Members only Corvettes gather at the old Bucks County Drive-In for a special photo shoot followed by 2 movies.

Jan. 1994 – The "Fuel Tank" – our Club's first published book was a compilation of members' favorite recipes – organized by Diane Waldron.

Nov. 1997 – Wendell Strode, from the NCM, was our guest speaker at the general membership meeting. CCDV paid for his travel expenses.

Sept. 2000 – "167" members in "93" Corvettes caravanned to Chip & Judy Miller's home at the Carlisle Fairgrounds for garage tours and Bar-B-Que.

Oct. 2000 – "84" CCDV Corvettes take part in the largest 16th Annual Hot Dog Run.

Nov. 2000 – CCDV membership hit 500!

May 2005 – Wil Abney (former CCDV - VP) turns himself in for the 1978 murder of his former wife (found strangled in a Holiday Inn in Fairfax, VA). It was DNA evidence that did him in!!

Sept. 2006 – Joe Mammana, CEO of Yardley Farms is our guest speaker. In early 2008, he is arrested for stealing an 18 wheeler with 10 brand new Corvettes!

Feb. 2008 – CCDV membership hits an all-time high at "605".

You could say we've had a very interesting Club history as these are just a few of the many crazy times in the life of CCDV.

After Breakfast , you have two great choices available:

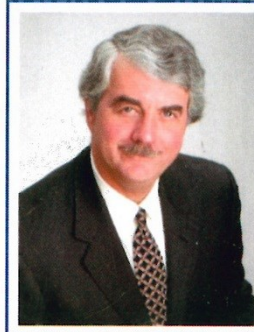
1. Drive North on York Road about .4 mile and take the right fork to stay on York Road.
