Birdman

Movie Review by Steve Nikazy















Director Alejandro Gonzalez Inarritu ("Babel," "21 Grams") brings together a group of superhero movie alum in a satisfying dramedy that explores self doubt and the need for critical acceptance in the film "Birdman."

The often under-utilized and ultra-talented Michael Keaton plays Riggan Thomson, a former star of blockbuster action hero movies who seeks a return to the spotlight, but wants to be accepted as a serious talent. Critics can't get past his role as "Birdman," in a theme that echos Keaton's real life experience as the original movie "Batman." Thanks to help from his ex-wife, Thomson pulls together what's left of his fortune and rolls the dice on a Broadway production in which he serves as director and star.

Edward Norton ("The Incredible Hulk,") stars as Mike Shiner, a successful but temperamental New York theater method actor, enlisted to play the lead role in Thomson's play about romance gone bad. There are tension filled scenes between Shiner and Thomson that lead to some amusing fisticuffs. Will a mutual admiration prevent a meltdown?

The film includes a face to face showdown between Thomson and a top NYC critic who slams the star, describing him as a pedestrian talent who played to the dirty masses. It's on screen candy for movie critics.

Emma Stone ("The Amazing Spider-Man") puts in a thoughtful performance as Thomson's neglected daughter Sam who tries to make sense of the opening night chaos surrounding her. She fears her father is being left behind in the Twitterverse and social media scene.

Zach Galifianakis is amazing as Thomson's producer/right hand man and it's great to see the comic actor pursuing a slightly different role. Naomi Watts also turns in a fine supporting performance.

The actors reportedly shot fifteen pages of dialogue for each scene and the scenes blend together. It's a fun but sometimes exhausting ride.

Then, there is the murky separation of reality and special effects. Telekinetic power and raspy narration by "The Birdman" are a constant presence in the movie. Is it really all in Thomson's head?

It's an A-Plus for originality and fine performances in a movie that truly spreads its wings.




