So here we go starting with the larger treasures: A very large artist framed drawing of our '76, a 30" square "DO NOT ENTER" street sign, a 30" official 8 sided STOP sign, a 24 x 30" official "SPEED LIMIT 25" & a "NO PARKING IN DRIVEWAY" authentic city street signs, 4 used tires including: an original Firestone Steel Radial 500 & 2 Goodyear Eagle GT-245-60-R15, my 4 original rally wheels + trim rings & center caps, a large hand drawn character sketch of me in my Navy uniform chasing some unknown redhead, an original 28 x 41" "Corvette Summer" 1978 movie poster, 2 wall clocks (1 from CCDV & 1 from Corvette's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary), 1 large "DANGER – HIGH VOLTAGE" red & black sign, my car show display poster by Don Terranova, over a dozen Cavalcade posters (yes I know they were NOT to be displayed in members' garages – so please don't tell anyone in CCDV?), a "NO STOPPING – ANYTIME" & a "NO PARKING – ANYTIME" authentic city street signs, plus 2 "Corvette Only – Parking" signs, a very large solid wood framed hanging display of the 1953 thru 1990 Corvettes – featuring the new ZR-1, a large 1976 Chevy dealer

#### And now it's time for some PS:



# **CECF CORNER**

In an effort to be fully transparent, it was brought to the attention of the CCDV Board that after the new CECF board members reviewed the financial records of the CECF it would not be possible to purchase a raffle vehicle for 2019 without cashing in at least one CD and taking a significant financial penalty. This is because the CECF checking account was depleted as a result of the generous gifts given away by the exiting CECF Board in January 2019. We understand that the newly elected officers were not invited to the funds distribution meeting and were thus unaware of the impact this would have on fundraising the following year. As background, in prior years the CECF Board would advise the CCDV Board regarding its year-end distributions to the charitable recipients. Unfortunately, this did do not occur this year. This recent revelation regarding insufficient funds in the CECF checking account took the CCDV Board by surprise. The CCDV Board was recently advised that the current CECF Board has understandably decided not to disturb the current funds that are included in CDs until maturity and are therefore looking at other avenues to raise money this year for the charities that have looked to us for support annually over the past 20 years. We look forward to the CECF Board sharing their proposals in the near future.




