MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT AUGUST 2020

r or the fifth straight month, I want to start this message by saying I hope every member and their families are staying healthy and making the best out of this ongoing virus situation.

Luckily, we did not have to cancel the July General Membership meeting, as you know, it was conducted outside in the parking lot at the VFW in Warminster. Approximately 20 cars and 35 members attended. It was nice seeing everybody again and their cars. For those who did not attend they had the capability to use **'ZOOM'** and watch the meeting from their home. The weather was beautiful and the meeting went very well. We did have a couple of small problems with the video and sound, but I will work with **Tim Simmons** to have those corrected for the **August** GM meeting at the **VFW**.

In my July President's Message, I wrote about the VFW having some financial difficulties. The club and its members wanted to assist the post and donate money towards their cause. **Joe Parente** presented to **Alex** and **John** (Post Officers) a **CECF** check for **\$750.00**. **Alex** spoke to the crowd and was very appreciative for the donation and stated that he would do everything to assist us in keeping the club as part of the **VFW**. The **50/50** totaled **\$191.00** which the **CCDV** portion of **\$96.00** was donated to the post and the winner donated his portion of **\$95.00** to the Post as well. In addition some members joined the **VFW** as social members and paying more than the **\$35.00** to join. As a reminder, social members get the same right as veteran members with use of the banquet room, kitchen and bar. A special **'Thank You'** goes out to the **CECF Board** and all those contributing to the post. These acts of kindness demonstrate the true spirit of our club's mission to support those in need.

The **August General Membership** meeting will start at "**7:00 PM**" and not at "**8:00 PM**" to accommodate an outside meeting. You can bring chairs, bug spray and food if you want.
