

Please note: The ballots that are cast at the meeting are anonymous. The absentee ballot is also anonymous, but the return envelope will include your name on it and the envelope must be signed. This step is necessary to keep track so there is no duplication of votes. If you request and return an absentee ballot, you may still attend the November meeting to vote, and your absentee ballot will be discarded at that time. Absentee ballots will not be open until the counting of the votes and the envelopes will be separated from the ballot at the time of opening.

# Corvette Enthusiasts Community Foundation (CECF)

#### The Corvette Enthusiasts Community Foundation

The Corvette Enthusiasts Community Foundation was formed in 1994 as a 501c.3 tax exempt organization by the members of the Corvette Club of Delaware Valley to be used to conduct tax advantaged charitable giving and educational scholarship activities of the club. Our foundation has contributed to date \$551,000 to worthy causes including The Sunshine Foundation, Juvenile Diabetes Foundation, many local food banks including Manna on Main Street, Mattie Dixon Community Cupboard, Caring for Friends, as well as other local community organizations such as Lenape Valley Foundation, Foster Angels on Earth, Philadelphia Vietnam Veterans Society, and many others.

The Officers and Board of Directors would like you to consider ways you might contribute towards our charitable giving. Many of us have been very fortunate and might consider donating something of value that the foundation could monetize. Of course, cash donations are always welcome. Our foundation does receive some cash donations each year. You might prefer to sell something that is no longer used by you and consider donating a portion or all the proceeds to the foundation. You might possibly be thinking about downsizing your collection and want to donate an automobile to our foundation. You might want to consider a Directive in your Trust or Will to benefit the Corvette Enthusiasts Community Foundation. While overall the raffle this year was a success, there are some concerns regarding club member participation.

Here are some facts regarding this past year's raffle:

- A total of 1402 tickets were sold, totaling \$28,040.
- However, more than half (764) of the tickets were sold by only 2 club members
- Total Club Membership is 363. Only 36 CCDV members (including 12 CCDV Board members) sold or purchased tickets during the last raffle. This level of participation is not a recipe for future success.
- This is your club and your foundation.

The CECF Board has given significant thought to how CECF can and should conduct fund raising this year and in future years as well. To be successful, we need as much participation as possible from club members.

To continue our charitable giving the Officers and Board of Directors would like to form a CECF Raffle Committee. We are seeking three or four volunteers. Please contact Charles Milstein, Bob Lear or Chris Merlino. We need to determine from the CCDV club members their level of interest in a raffle. What type of raffle? How we should go about conducting the raffle, etc. We need to know what club members want and are willing to support.

This committee would report to the CECF Board and would be responsible for planning and conducting fund raising for our foundation by raffle or other means and should be a minimum of three people from the club. To be successful we need to get some fresh perspectives and ideas to generate the member participation necessary for success. These are our thoughts.

  - o Don't point your camera towards the sun (best to have the sun at your side).
  - Watch for excessive sun glare on your windshield or chrome.
  - o Keep windows down to prevent reflection or glare
  - o A "closed hood" looks better & requires less print space than an "open hood" photo.
  - Verify your email address hasn't changed since joining the club. This information must stay current.
  - o For the 2024 Calendar, please submit a new or different photo of your Vette. We won't be re-using old photos. If you submit a photo, it will be in the calendar.
- Email 1 or 2 of your favorite photos to: webmaster@ccdv.com. Be sure you receive an acknowledgement email (sometimes messages with attachments are sent to the Spam folder).


