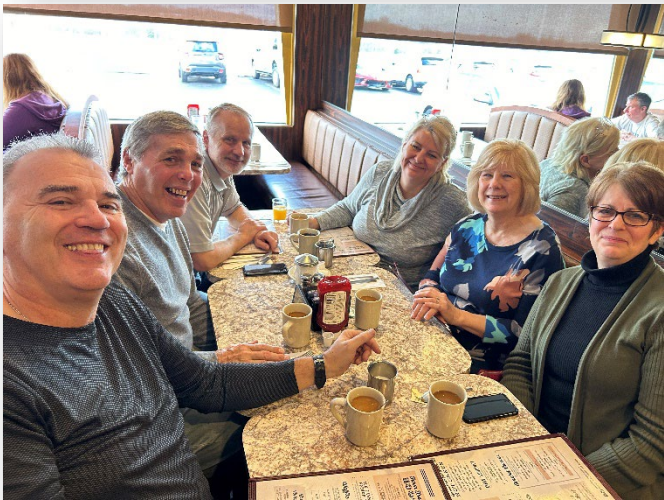

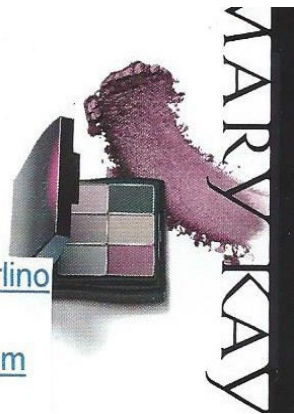



In no event shall CCDV be liable to any third - party for damages related to using or not using its content whether claims are advanced on contract, tort or other legal theories.
