Seems every classic car has a story. That certainly is the case with my 1969 Corvette.

My ownership journey began when I was very young. The original owner of this car Edward R. "Butch" Moore was my father's best friend when I was born in 1967. Butch bought this car new from Horning Chevrolet in Royersford, PA from a salesman named Bud Frey. Butch helped my father start a car dealership in 1972 where I spent lots of time with my dad in my formidable years in the early 1970's. That is where I caught the car bug, especially for Corvettes! As my dad's best friend, Butch and I spent quite a bit of time together. I recall just riding along with him on errands then going for ice cream. I felt like one of his own, and in a sense I still do.

I learned of Butch's Corvette when I was about 10 years old and expressed interest in buying it from him "someday when I get a job". He would always give me the same answer "you'll have to talk to my grandchildren about that". Butch simply enjoyed owning it, not necessarily driving it, in fact I have no recollection of him ever driving it. The 8,000 miles on the odometer are indeed actual. Many years have passed but, I always knew where this Corvette was and have sometimes heard stories from others about "a local 69 Corvette with under 10,000 miles". I never tipped my hand that I knew where it was.

It turns out that his grandchildren really weren't interested in cars, but I still love Corvettes. Before his passing Butch remembered and gave me first right of refusal on the car I've wanted for so long. He was a good friend but also a good businessman so, I needed to pay a fair price. It was a stretch but the very car that has occupied my mind as a young Corvette loving boy now sits in my garage.




