6) Auction Items:

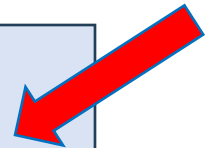
- Please look around for any items that you can donate to our Charity Auction

MY CORVETTE STORY – Evan Stone

My love for corvettes started as a boy. I was about 10 when I was struck by the “vette bug”. My father was the principal at the local vocational technical high school and had become friendly with the auto mechanics teacher, Dominic Leonetti. Dom was a retired army veteran and lived the bachelor life in Point Pleasant New Jersey. Dom owned a '55 Chevy street rod and a 1958 C2. It was white with a red interior and every time we would visit him, I would drool over the vette and ask to go for a ride.

Fast forward many, many years and around my 48th birthday, I started to finally casually “car shop” for a corvette. While I loved Dom’s C2, my true love was the C3 body style. To me it was just an iconic sports car and the lines just screamed “fast”! My wife Lisa was supportive of my passion and so was my son, Andrew. I would take Andrew on test drives as I “kicked the tires” on many C3s in all states of as-is condition from project cars to respectable drivers. I knew I didn’t want a project car and Lisa and I agreed on a budget. By this point my son was deep into the process, so much so that he was shopping for cars during his high school graphics class instead of doing his work!

One day, while in class, Andrew sends me a Craigslist ad for a 1974, four speed, Dark Metallic Brown C3. The car was in Telford PA and was owned by a young man who was expecting his first child and needed money to put an addition on his house. His need was my good fortune, and the deal was struck! At 49 I finally owned my first vette! As part of the sale, I had the car inspected by Sean from the Vette Shop. At the time I lived just minutes away from his shop in Northampton. Sean told me about CCDV and so I joined in 2013. I’ve met a lot of great friends along the way.

Eleven years later I am in my third corvette, a 1 of 1, 2023 3LT, HTC in Hypersonic Gray. While I miss the '74 C3 and the '16 C7, I am loving every minute in the C8!

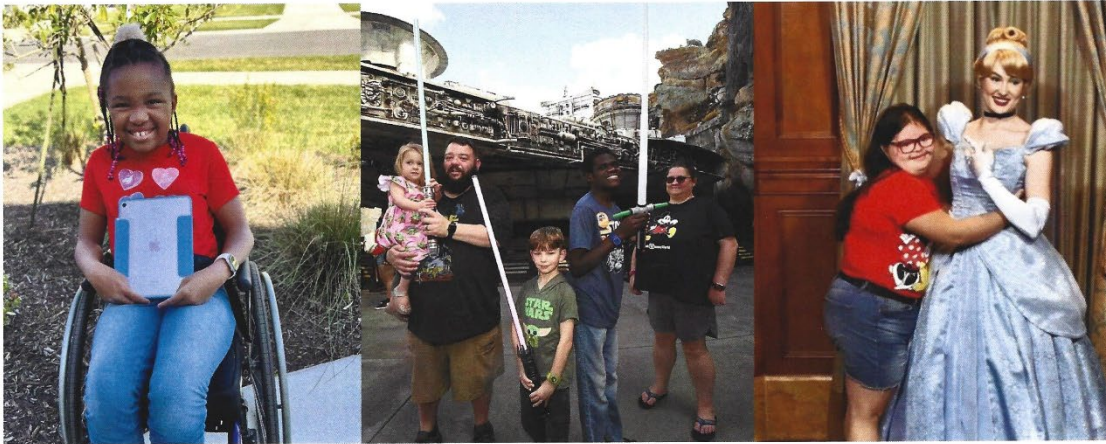

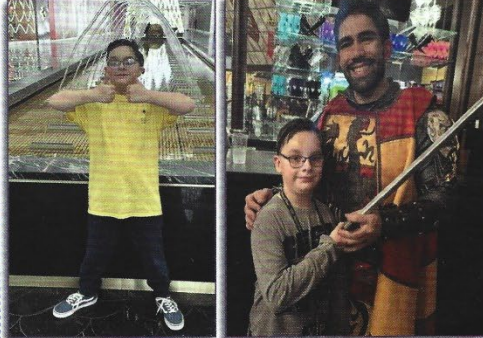

Bruce said, "I loved riding on the electric animals... it was so much fun."

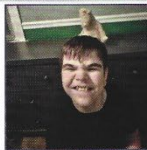

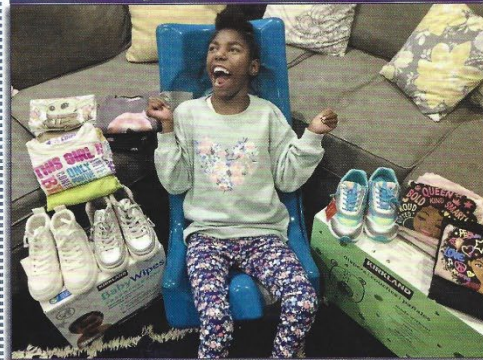

Beginning January 2023, the “The Vette Shop” officially purchased “Corvette Chassis Concepts” from Ray Leicht. Sean Farrell is the 30-year owner of The Vette Shop, a 20,000 sq ft restoration and service facility where projects are completed ranging from original restorations to custom resto-mod builds. Over the last 10 years the shop had seen a large shift from "nut and bolt, numbers matching" restorations to the resto-mod builds. The Vette Shop was feeling the effects of the covid supply chain issues. They could not provide their customers with chassis from the big aftermarket frame companies due to extreme delivery lead times. Our solution was to start building our own chassis to supply The Vette Shop and our future customers with quality performance chassis.

Chassis Concepts is now operating out of a 4,000 sq ft building at The Vette Shop where production of the chassis are being controlled start to finish. We offer a variety of builds including building your chassis from scratch, assembling the drivetrain, body/paint work, and provide you with a running and driving resto-mod corvette of your dreams. For those customers who would prefer to build their own resto-mod with one of our chassis we have the resources to provide you with a great product and the support to help you through the process.

Our main goal is customer support and building a quality product. For this business, it's imperative to have an example of each model offered at the shop. So, we did just that. With the help of our lead fabricator, Rob Wood, we have test fit, changed, and perfected the fit of a C1, C2, and C3 Corvette body on our frames. As Chassis Concepts moves forward, we are working with another large local company and their state-of-the-art equipment to 3D scan and blueprint all of our products. Our frames will no longer be set by tape measure and squares alone. We have the capability to create and re-create exact specifications down to the .001 of an inch. This will provide a quicker turn around time and near eliminate any human error. We are looking forward to working with you and we are excited for this pivotal moment for us in the corvette industry.

FREE STATE CORVETTE CLUB

We are excited to announce Corvette Weekend in Ocean City, MD will be back **November 8th and 9th, 2024.**

While it hurt our club and all the participants not to hold the Ocean City event in 2023, the real hurt was felt by the charities we support each year. Those charities count on the money raised by this event as a major means of fundraising each year through the Free State Corvette Club Foundation which is a 501c3 non-profit organization.

The Free State Corvette Club of MD has hosted this event (with 100% volunteers) for 35 years and has generated close to \$1 million dollars for Maryland based 501c3 charities which primarily benefit children and veterans. 100% of the funds we raise each year go to organizations such as Spina Bifida of Maryland to help buy wheelchairs and Heroes on the Water to buy kayaks used to help in the rehabilitation of wounded veterans. Bennett Blazers children's basketball team counts on our donation to help with wheelchair sports and Gilchrist Kids pediatric hospice program uses the funds donated to help families during what is surely the most difficult situations we can imagine.

To make up for the funds usually raised during Ocean City Weekend we are sponsoring a raffle for a new 2024 C-8 Corvette Stingray, INCLUDING THE REQUIRED FEDERAL WITHHOLDING TAX**. 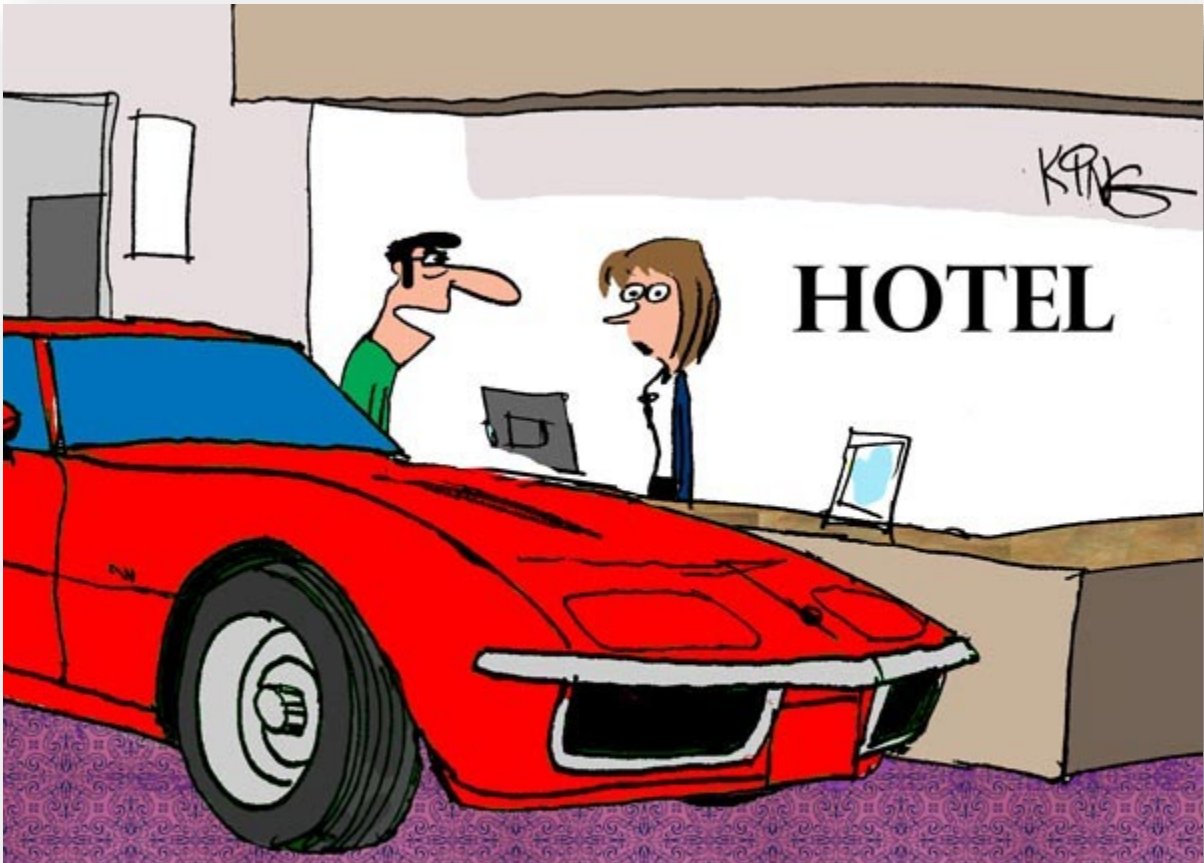

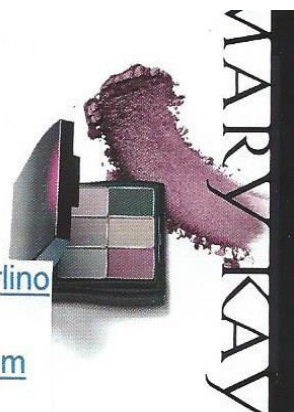
