# MY CORVETTE STORY - Zach Hamada

My relationship with corvettes began when I was in grade school and one of my older sisters had a friend that was an active military member during the Vietnam war. He had a C2. I do not know what year it was as at the time, the only thing I knew about the car was that it looked cool. He lived in an apartment building that was on my way to school so I would see the car in the parking lot most days. I would tell all my friends that my sister's friend owned the car, and he was in the army.

When I became driving age, I had a Pontiac Trans Am as my best friend's father owned a Pontiac dealership. I remember seeing my sister's friend at a party and struck up a conversation with him about cars as I remembered him for his car. When I told him proudly that I had a Trans Am he just shook his head and said I needed to get the bird and all that s..t off my car. Needless to say, I was devastated.

Years later I sold the Pontiac and purchased my first vette. Not because of what he said, I was over that, but because I just really liked the car. It was a 1970 4 speed convertible with a hard top. I absolutely loved that car, and the cat calls I got from the girls when I was driving it. I was 20 at the time so I did a lot of the work on the car myself. It was an AC car that I never used so of course I stripped all that equipment off the car and subsequently lost it, UGH. I sold the car for the exact amount I paid for it, \$3,000. I thought that was great. Of course, today, like many other vette owners I wished I had never parted with that car.

Since then, I have owned a 50th anniversary convertible, a 1960 fairly original, except for paint and my present 2021. When I feel it is time to scratch the itch, I sometimes feel, I will look for a 68 to 72 that I can restomed or find one already done. But that is a story for another day,




